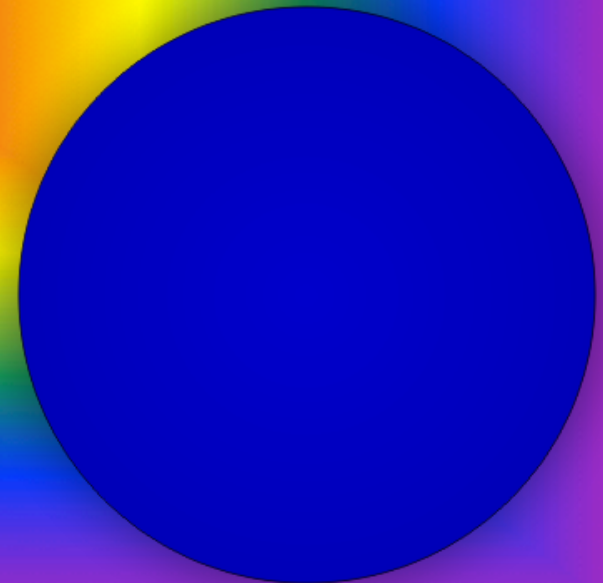
We discussed a variety of different ideas of how we can save energy throughout the school and decided we would concentrate on making sure lights were not left on when not in use.

We came up with the idea of the traffic light system.

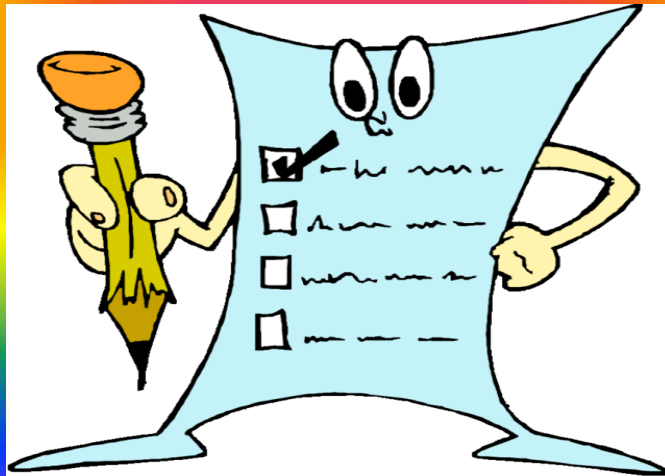
- RED- Red means don't turn on the light
- AMBER- Amber means you can turn it on sometimes but not all of the time
- GREEN- Green means you can turn it on whenever you want.

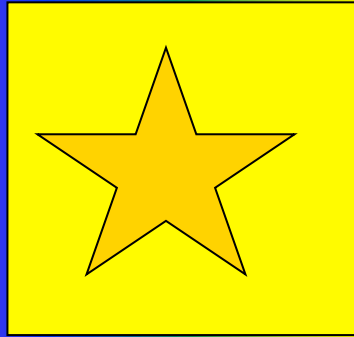


- We also have blue stickers on our plug sockets.
- If you have a blue sticker on your plug socket you can turn it off if not in use.
- But if you have no sticker on a plug socket you **HAVE** to keep the plug socket on and **DON'T** turn off the plug socket.

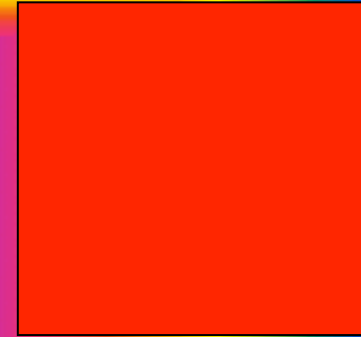
